

THE UCAT CONSORTIUM PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATION RULES

Please read these rules carefully as they explain what you must do if you have any issues during testing.

- You may only test once in any test cycle. Instances of multiple testing in the same cycle will be treated as unprofessional behaviour and all results withdrawn.
- In attending to test you are declaring yourself fit to take the test. If you feel unwell you should reschedule to a later date. We will not consider such health issues as mitigating circumstances.
- If you feel ill during your test, raise your hand to notify the administrator. If you do not do this your illness will not be accepted as mitigating circumstances. If you are not well enough to continue testing please contact the UCAT Office as soon as possible.
- The test cannot be paused. If you need a break to take medication or to use the toilets, please raise your hand to notify the invigilator. The test will continue running - you will lose time whilst out of the test room.
- If you experience hardware/software problems, noise disturbance or other distractions, notify the administrator *immediately* by raising your hand. If you do not do this, such circumstances will not be accepted as mitigating circumstances. The administrator cannot answer questions related to test content.
- Personal belongings (including bags, coats, papers, pens, watches, wallets, keys, ID, mobile phones, food/drinks and unpermitted head apparel) are not allowed in the test room and should be placed in the lockers provided. Electronic devices should be turned off before being stored. The test centre is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.
- The administrator will log you in, verify that you are taking the correct test and start your test.
- You may request ear plugs. Headphones are available at workstations and may be used to block out noise.
- A marker and a set of noteboards are provided which should not be removed from the test room. If you fill your noteboards, raise your hand to notify the administrator.
- During your test you will have access to a simple on-screen calculator.
- Making noise that may disturb other candidates is prohibited during the test.
- To ensure a high level of security, you will be monitored at all times using CCTV.
- After completing the test, raise your hand. The administrator will check your test has ended properly and escort you from the room. You will be given a printed score report after leaving the test room.
- You may not share or discuss the questions or answers from your test with other candidates.

Your privacy : Your exam results will be encrypted and transmitted to Pearson VUE and the exam sponsor. The test centre does not retain any information other than when and where your exam was taken.
