

## The UCAT Consortium Registration Questionnaire 2020

The UCAT Consortium seeks to minimise bias due to factors such as age, gender, nationality, ethnicity or socio-economic background. In order to do this we collect demographic, admissions and educational data on applicants to medical and dental schools in the UK.

The data collected below provides the Consortium with an effective, reliable mechanism for the administration of the test, the verification of the fairness and internal reliability of the test and allows UCAT to undertake research related to admissions to medicine and dentistry.

Research and analysis only takes place on anonymised data and the Consortium is committed to ensuring that no individuals or groups can be identified in any published research undertaken on its behalf. For clarity, none of the data collected below is passed to Universities during or after the admissions cycle.
