

UCAT Test Statistics 2020 (Update 14th October 2020)

- The following data is valid up to the 12th October 2020 based on 34,020 tests taken.
- There are approximately 200 candidates yet to test; the results of these candidates are not likely to affect the scores below. We will provide an update when all candidates have tested.
- We are monitoring the performance of candidates taking the test in test centres and those testing online and will publish this once the analysis is complete.

Mean Total Score (to 12th October)

- The total cognitive mean scaled score is **2512**.
- The mean scaled scores of the **cognitive subtests** are below

Cognitive Subtest	2020 (to 12 Oct)
Verbal Reasoning	570
Decision Making	625
Quantitative Reasoning	664
Abstract Reasoning	653

The scaled score range for each cognitive subtest is 300 – 900.

Decile Ranking (to 12th October)

The following table provides deciles of candidate total scores. Each decile represents 10% of candidates based on their overall test performance. The 1st decile represents a score at the 10th percentile; the 2nd decile represents a score at the 20th percentile, and so on.
