

Alternative ID for Candidates Testing in a UK Test Centre

If you are taking the test in a UK test centre and cannot present one of the permitted forms of ID, there is a fall-back solution. Note: this fall-back ID cannot be used for an online-proctored UCAT.


Please ask your school/college to attach your photograph to its headed paper and include the following text:

"This document is to confirm the identity of our student [insert your name], date of birth [insert your date of birth], whose signature appears below, endorsed with the official stamp of the school [that covers part of the photograph]."

Please note the following:

- The letter must be signed by a head teacher or a senior member of staff.
- You must also sign this document.
- It must bear the school stamp, which should cover part of your photograph.
- The photograph used must be clear and you must be easily identified from it.
