

Alternative ID for Candidates Testing in a UK Test Centre

If you are taking the test in a UK test centre and cannot present one of the permitted forms of ID, there is a fall-back solution. This fall-back ID cannot be used for OnVUE online proctored testing.



Please ask your school/college or university to attach your photograph (digital or physical) to its headed paper and include the following text:

"This document is to confirm the identity of our student [insert your name], date of birth [insert your date of birth], whose signature and photograph appears below, endorsed with our official stamp [that covers part of the photograph]."

Please note the following:

- The letter must be signed by a head teacher or a senior member of staff.
- You must also sign this document.
- It must bear the institution's official stamp, which should cover part of your photograph. If the institution does not have a stamp, the signatory of the letter must sign their name over part of your photograph.
- The photograph must be clear and a true likeness.
